1. APJC –PL Members were requested to approve a revised version of Financial Criteria for Accrediting IATA Agents in Poland, presented by APJC-PL Airlines representatives at the APJC meeting on 9th June 2008 and shown as **'revised proposal'** attachment that consists of:

2. If approved, the financial would come into effect as from 1st January 2009 with an annual transition period, during which the required financial guarantee would be at the level of 50% of the result obtained from the calculation worksheet.
