Dear Mrs Wolf,

As a consequence of the COVID-19 pandemic, a number of IATA Agents asked the Polish Chamber of Tourism (PIT), to send a request to IATA to extend the deadline for submitting financial statements by 90 days for the financial year 2019 which normally should be delivered by the end of June 2020.

Agencies are still understaffed to save costs. The remaining staff is mostly busy with refund claims, rebookings, vouchers etc. Many auditing accountants engaged by Agencies are now on unpaid leave. Additionally, after careful consideration of many COVID-19 government regulations we would like you to find a link to the appropriate one concerning legal changes in national law regarding the 90-day extension of financial statements submission as follows:
